I Handy Reddick of Stokes County & State
of North Carolina being very sick & weak but
of peaceful mind and memory thanks to almighty
God Calling to mind the mutability of my body and
knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die do make & ordain this my last will
and Testament in following manner (that is to say)
first of all I give and recommend My soul into
the hands of almighty God that gave it my
body I recommend unto the earth to be buried
in a decent manner at the discretion of
my Ex^{ors} nothing doubting but at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty power of God. And as
touching ~~my~~ worldly Estate wherewith it
hath pleased God to bless me with I give
devise & dispose of the same in the following
manner first of all I give to my beloved
wife Mourning Reddick the Plantation
I now live on with the tract of land
thereunto belonging also all my Stock
together with all my House hold goods

during her natural life or widowhood
 after her decease I give the my son Henry
 Reddick the said land and Plantation
 with all the improvements thereon
 I give to my son John Reddick part
 of Meadow track of land so called on
 the south ~~side~~ of the Spring branch I
 also give to my son Abraham Reddick
 the north side of the said Spring
 branch to the line between them I also
 give to my son Thomas Reddick the
 Carter track of land lying on the
 of H. Calshole Creek I give my collection
 of land to my executor to sell the money
 made use of in schooling my children
 if any surplus I also give it to my
 daughter Mourning Reddick and my
 daughter Sarah Reddick I also give
 to my daughter ^{Elizabeth} ~~John~~ Reddick and
 Charles Reddick and Michael Reddick
 Ten pounds a piece out of the personal
 Estate if there is any surplus at the
 decease of the widow let it be equally
 divided amongst all my children

now living with me I also give to my daughter
 Louisa Heath five Shillings I also give to
 my daughter Nancy Clark five Shillings
 I have appointed my wife Mourning Reddick
 & my son John Reddick my executors -
