I Jacob Meier of the County of Stokes in the
State of North Carolina formerly being weak in
body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be
given to gods: Calling unto mind the matters
of men & knowing it to be appointed for all
men once to die, do make & ordain this my
last Will & Testament viz: First of all I
recommend my Soul to my Creator & my
Body to be buried in decent Christian
burial on the burying ground in Frederick

and as to my worldly Estate I commend it to
God who has blessed me in this World I give & devise the same
in manner & form following viz:

1) I give & bequeath unto my dear son Jacob
William all my plantation whereon I now
live with all improvements & lands thereunto
belonging as his own sole property forever
on the following condition Viz: He shall
pay after my death all my Just debts &
funeral expenses with all the incidentals
charges thereon & the said Jacob William
shall likewise pay unto my other children
the following sums: Namely; to my two sons
John & Frederick & to my three daughters Catharine
Married to Moses Jarvis; Eva married to
Alexander Harker Mary married to Alexander
Harker each of them the sum of ten pounds five
shillings lawful money of North Carolina & to the
children of my deceased daughter Gertrude the
sum of nine pounds lawful money each of my
said children to have the said sums within
two years after my death

2d) I do hereby make a dain Constable & appoint
my truly friend Jacob Bloom Person & his Rightly
loved of Salem in Stokes County Executor to this my
last Will & Testament; I do hereby disannul &
make void all my former Wills & legacies done
by me either in Writing or by word of
