I Dudley Gatwood of the County of Stokes and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound disposing mind memory do this 15th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty six make & declare this my last will & Testament in manner & form as follows viz:

- First - It is my express will & desire that all my Estate both real & personal as soon as convenient after my decease shall be sold and the money arising from the sale of the same after paying all my just debts & funeral expenses shall be divided as herein after and bequeathed.
- Secondly - I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Lemytia Gatwood one seventh part of all the money arising from the sale of my estate after paying all my debts & ~~the four bequests~~ ^{and} during her natural life.
- Thirdly - I give & bequeath to my son George Gatwood one dollar to him & his heirs forever.
- Fourthly - I give & bequeath to my son Horace Gatwood one dollar to him & his heirs forever.
- Fifthly - I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Gatwood to her & her heirs forever one dollar.
- Sixthly - I give & bequeath to my son John Gatwood one dollar to him & his heirs forever.
- Seventhly - I give & bequeath to my ten following children namely William Gatwood, Elijah Gatwood, Henry Gatwood, Mary Gatwood, Robert Gatwood & Richard Gatwood & their heirs forever one seventh part each of all the money arising from the sale of my estate after paying all my just debts & four dollars to the above named children who have each one dollar bequeathed them.
- Eighthly - I give & bequeath to my daughter Anna Jones & her heirs all that part bequeathed to my wife which she may leave at her death.
- Ninthly - I do hereby appoint & constitute my son William Gatwood Executor to this my last will & testament, at the same time attorney working all other wills made by me. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affix my seal the day & year above written. Signed, sealed & delivered in presence of

I Charles Cuttis senior of the County of Stokes & State of North Carolina being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thinks beginning unto God, calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this my last will & testament, that is to say, principally first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors. I give & devise & dispose of my estate in the following manner.

- First, I will that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate.
- Second, I give & bequeath to my son Charles Cuttis Jr. Southwark part of my plantation wherein he now lives viz: beginning at a stake on Thomas Fisher line, thence east thirteen chains, twelve & a half links to a stake in the beach, thence North thirty two chains nineteen links thence West thirteen chains twelve & a half links to the above named Fisher line, thence South to the beginning containing forty two acres more or less.
- Third I give & bequeath to my daughter Catherine wife of Conrad Rosings sixteen acres of my land including the building there
