Now know all men by these presents that I will that my wife Catharine shall have and enjoy all her legacy both real and personal which she has had willed to her by her father George Brown to her sole property forever and I also will that my daughter Elizabeth shall have one acre of land from my home tract plantation which I have willed to my son Francis who shall have surveyed off the same as near four acres as can be in the North West corner of said tract and so when else —

In the name of God Amen I Name Edas of the County of Hoke & State of North Carolina being in good health & perfect memory thank God almighty God and calling to the remembrance the uncertain state of his transitory life and that all flesh must yield unto Death when it shall please God to call do make constitute ordain and declare this my last Will and testament in manner and in form following. Reciting and affirming by these presents all and every testament & testamentary wills hitherto by me made and declared either by word or writing and this only is to be taken for my last will and testament and no other.

I trust bring penitent glory from the bottom of my heart for my sins past most humbly desiring forgiveness for the same I give and commit my soul unto almighty God my savior and redeemer in whom and by the merits of Jesus Christ I trust and believe apurely to be saved and to have full remission and forgiveness of all my sins and that my soul with my body at the general day of resurrection shall rise again with joy and thos the merits of Christ death & passion & pay and inherit the kingdom of heaven prepared for his elect & chosen and my body to be buried in such a place as it shall please my executors hereafter named to appoint and now for the settling of my temporal estate and such good chattels and debts as is hath pleased God for above my debts to bishow upon me I do ordain give and despose the same in manner and in form following that is to say. I trust swell that all those debts and dues which I owe in right or Conscience to manner of person or persons whatsoever shall be曳 and truly accounted and paid or demanded to be paid within convenient time after my decease by my executors named. Item I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah my house land where I now live containing one hundred and one acre joining Charles Griffin Richard with

and William Badget & others also my household and furniture and stock of all kinds hogs hores cattle sheep and all mors due me either by bonds open or book amounts during her life & more than the said land house hold furniture and stock of all kind to be equally divided between my son Robert William Bartlett James Isaac Davis Nancy started Elizabeth Pally.  
I do hereby ordain and appoint Charles Griffin Wright Seales my true and lawful executors of this my last will and testament nothing doubting but they and every of them will fully faithfully execute the same which I do truly acknowledge this to be my last will and testament and affix my name to the same this the twenty first day of July one thousand eight hundred eighteen in the presence

All the money after my other just debts, funeral expenses and a reasonable allowance to my executors is paid shall be equally divided between Elizabeth Miller Margaret Miller Catharine Miller Mary Miller David Miller Daniel Miller Sarah Miller grand Children of mine by Loddy Miller and Mary Miller both Miller being Miller Harmon children Charles Miller Charity Miller Sarah Miller Children of my son Harmon their heirs of legal age to be paid to them at their coming of age - And the interest arising from the shares of the last mentioned Children shall be paid to their Mother Harmon for their support.

And I do appoint my truly dear beloved friends Henry Clarmayne & Henry Knapp or the survivor of them executors of this my last will Testament and authorize them on the sale of the land or the survivor of them to make such a Reeds for the same -

And I hereby revoke annall and make void every and all former Wills by me made antenavely this only to be my last Will and Testament.
