 presents that I will that my wife Catharine shall have
 and enjoy all her legacy both real and personal
 which she has had willed to her by her father George
 Thum to be her sole property forever and I also will
 that my daughter Elizabeth shall have one acre of
 land from my home stead plantation which I
 have willed to my son Frederick who shall have
 surveyed off the same as near from equum as can
 be in the North West corner of said tract and
 no other lot —

 and that my soul with my body at the general day of
 resurrection shall rise again with joy and thro the merits
 of Christ death & passion pass and inhabit the kingdom
 of heaven prepared for his elect & chosen and my body to
 be buried in such a place as it shall please my executor
 hereafter named to appoint and now for the settling of
 my temporal Estate and such good chattels and debts as it hath
 pleased God for above my debts to bestow upon me I do order
 give and dispose the same in manner and in form following
 that is to say, First I will that all those debts and dues which
 I owe in right or conscience to manner of person or persons
 whatsoever shall be well and truly contented and paid or
 ordained to be paid within convenient time after my decease
 by my executors named. Next I give and bequeath to my
 wife Sarah my home land where I now live containing one
 Hundred and one acre joining Charles Griffin Richard Mills

and William Padget & others also my household and
furniture and stock of all kinds hogs horses cattle sheep
and all means due me within by bonds open or book
accounts during her ~~life~~ ^{lifelong} than the said land
house hold furniture and stock of all kind to be equally
divided between my son Robert William Bartlett
James Isaac David Nancy Charlotte Elizabeth Polly.
I do hereby ordain and appoint Charles Griffin Joseph
Seales my true and lawful executors of this my
last will and testament nothing doubting but they
and every of them will fully & faithfully execute the same
which I do truly acknowledge this to be my last will
and testament and assign my name to the same
this the twenty first day of July one thousand eight
hundred & sixteen in the presence

and a reasonable allowance to my executors is paid shall be
equally divided between Elizabeth Miller Margaret Miller
Catharine Miller Mary Miller David Miller Daniel Miller
Sarah Miller grand Children of mine by Esq. Miller and
Mary Miller John Miller Henry Miller Harmon Miller Charles
Miller Charity Miller Sarah Miller Children of my son
Harmon their heirs of legal age to be paid to them at
their coming of age - And the interest arising from the
shares of the last mentioned Children shall be paid to
their Mother Salmon for their support.

And I do appoint my trusty Well beloved friends Henry
Hamon Esquire & Henry Kapp or the survivor of them executors
of this my last will & testament And authorize them on the
sale of the land or the survivor of them to make such
a deeds for the same -

And I hereby revoke all and make void
every and all former Wills by me made acknowledge
this only to be my last will and testament.
