thanks be given unto God. Capping these minds
the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is
for all men once to die do make and ordain
this my last Will and testament that is to

the sum of five Shillings of lawful money
of this State to be raised & levied out of
my estate

Also I give to my well beloved daughter
Mary Hill the sum of five pounds of
lawful money of this State to be raised
& levied out of my estate

The remainder part of my Estate to be
equally divided amongst all my children
including Mary to have their equal parts
and about the five pounds
above written Joshua my son only
excluded from having an equal part
with the rest of my children.

I likewise constitute make and ordain
Thomas Gladjet sole executor
of this my last will & Testament
and I do hereby utterly disallow
revoke and annul all and every
other former Testament Will Legacies
Bequests and executors by me in
any ways before named written
and bequeathed ratifying & confirming
this and no other to be my last
will and Testament.
