 Lowrey my father his Furniture & household the
 st. Anabell die before she get it st. his in her possession
 then her sister Margaret is to have said his
 Furniture And also give & bequeath to my
 Grand son Hugh McMillen One Dollar to be
 paid in Cash & the balance of my estate I give
 to be equally divided between my two daughters
 in law namely Hannah Lowrey & Jean
 Lowrey & my Daughter Mary Walker And
 I hereby make and Ordain my son John Lowrey
 Executor of this my last will & testament In Witness
 Whereof I the said Spable Lowrey have to this my
 last will & testament at my hand & seal
 the Day & Year above Written.
