Likewise I make constitute and appoint Andrew Joseph executor of the my last will and testament.

Item - I give & devise to my daughter Susan one dollar

Item - I give & devise to my son Robert one dollar

Item - I give & devise to my daughter Sally wife of David Anderson one dollar

Item - I give & devise to my daughter Martha one dollar

Item - I give & devise to my daughter Isabella wife of Horatio Whetton one dollar

Item - I give & devise to my son Meridith one dollar

Item - I give & devise to my daughter Rebecca one dollar

Item - I give & devise to my son Harry Thirty dollars.

Item - I give & devise to my daughter Jane one dollar
