I Jacob Miller of Stokes County in the State of North Carolina being at this present time very sickly & weak in body but yet of sound and well suspending mind and memory do make and retain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following viz: I commend my soul unto the Hand of almighty God my Creator & Savior and my body I commit unto the earth to be buried interred according to the direction of my friends of this my Will which are hereafter named and so touching such Worldly Estate wherewith please God to bless me with in this life I distribute the same among my children in the following manner

- 1.) I do give devise & bequeath unto my Eldest son John that tract of land he now lives on containing about 250 acres
- 2.) I give and bequeath unto my son John the 218 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres of land wherein he now lives
- 3.) I give and bequeath unto my son John

that tract of land he now lives on and for which I have heretofore made him a Deed for the same

4.) I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob the plantation and tract of land thence belonging and the same comprising as all or also one of my horses at his choice a wagon with 4 ears and all things thereunto belonging a Bushcar plough and Horse plough with implements belonging to the same Mall Rugs & Iron Wires a wooden Hoe a Dungfork Dungfork Spade Pitchfork and half part of all Tubs & Casks belonging to the distillery also the Iron Stove in my House (provided he furnishes the same Hannah with a good Stove from a sister) also a drawing knife a hand ad and iron Hatchet

5.) It is my will that my executors discharge all my just debts and recover all my just claims & I further nominate and appoint my then beloved sons Joseph Jacob & Judah joint Executors of this my last Will & Testament

6.) It is further my Will that all my other property not herein mentioned shall be sold according to the direction of my executors aforesaid

to the best advantage they can make  
and that out and from the monies  
arising from such sale as will otherwise  
my Elder Daughter Johanna Tolon  
wife of Jacob Hause in Pennsylvania  
shall have thirty five pounds lawful  
money of this State (Mr. Head money)  
Eighty seven dollars & one half of a  
hundred one hundred & twenty four  
~~repeatedly~~ to be paid to her separately  
by my son Joseph. And my daughter  
Catharia wife of Pittie Rothrock of  
this County shall besides what before  
received of me yet have the sum of one  
hundred then dollars Seven Shillings for  
her share and have the rest put in  
him up provided he pays the same for  
them or

and my daughter Elizabeth wife of James  
Hutton of this County shall have that  
part of land she now lies on containing  
about 203 acres

and my Daughter Hannah widow of  
John Hause deceased shall have a  
sum of Two hundred Adwary five &  
for her share

And lastly it is my will that in case that  
the monies arising from the sale aforesaid  
and otherwise should not amount to a sum  
sufficient to pay the sums mentioned to  
the 3 of my daughters in such case then  
of my Children I have herein given the lands  
as aforesaid shall as will pay an equal  
share to each such deficit as also the said my  
3 daughters from their several sums shall  
bear an apportionment share also as conformable  
to the true meaning and intention of this  
my will and on the other hand in case  
the sum collected by my executors for the sale  
aforesaid &c should amount to more than what  
I have set apart for the 3 of my daughters  
then such surplus shall be divided equally  
divided amongst all my Children share and  
share alike

And I do hereby and by virtue of this moode  
disannule and make void all my former  
will and Testaments made by me either  
by word or in writing thereby declaring  
these presents to be finally my last will  
and Testaments In witness whereof

I the said Jacob Miller have this  
my last will and Testament set my  
Hand and affixed my seal this last  
day of October in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred thirty four
