

65. 2nd. I give to Henry Floyd all that part of my land lying to the south of big Dan River the line to crop said River at a cliff below the fork. & to keep the dividing ridge until it intersects with the East line also a negro girl named Nancy a black Horn & Calf.

3rd. I give James Nunn all my land lying in the fork of Dan River the line extending up little Dan to the mouth of a branch which empties in on the East side of said River running up said branch to where my line crosses it. My will & desire also is that at the expiration of three years the money arising from the sale or hire of all land which we shall make choice of shall be coming to him also a Somme Horn and feather Bed.

4th. I give to my son Thomas Nunn all the balance of my lands also two negro boys Ben & George my desire is likewise that he should take charge of Nancy and let her have her liberty so as to let her have whatever she wants for her use or Cow & Calf the Choice of my Stock from head of Hogs one feather Bed & one third part of the house hold Kitchen furniture & working tools also six barrels of corn 5th. After the Stock is wintered & a sufficient support for the family laid in for the ensuing year, my will & desire is that the whole of the remaining part of my Stock of cattle hogs with the balance of grain which shall be left & remaining $\frac{2}{3}$ of the house hold Kitchen Furniture & Working tools be equally divided between Henry Floyd & James Nunn together with what Crockery shall be found left & due me and lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint Brother William Nunn & James S. Gaines Executors of this my Last Will & testament

1st. I hereby constitute my wife Polly & my brother
Naaman Hobbs to executors of this my last will & testament

2nd. I give & bequeath to my wife the land of plantation I now
live on during & to the time when my son Alfred comes of age
then the land to be equally divided between my said son
Alfred & my daughter Sabory each an half.

3rd. And for the remainder of the property that it has pleased
God to bless me with Negroe Horses &c my will & desire is that
my wife have the use benefit of it till my son comes of age
the said negroe stock & furniture to be taken care of for
her & my children support & education and as soon as my said
son Alfred attains the year of 21 years then my said
negroe horses cattle stock & furniture be equally divided
between my said wife & my two children & in case of the death
of any of these parties my land & property to go to the
survivor or survivor of them in this way if one of my
children should die then the surviving child to have the

whole of my land & I share equally with its mother
my personal property.

in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred & four
I Jacob House of the County of Stokes State of North Carolina
being in perfect health strength of body & mind knowing that it
is allotted for all men once to die do make & ordain this to
be my last will & testament and first I recommend my soul
into the hands of Almighty God that gave it me & my body to the
Earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion
of my executors hereafter named and as to my worldly estate
wherewith it hath pleased god to bless me with I dispose of
it in the following manner

I promise & give & bequeath to my daughter Hannah
a cow and her feather bed and furniture when she
marries or at my death. this being equivalent to what I
do her her heirs forever.

Item It is my will & desire that all the money I have on
Interest and outstanding debts that can be conveniently paid
out of my estate besides what is necessary for the support &
training of my children be continued out on interest & payable
until after my wife's Decease when it is to be equally
divided amongst my children namely Jacob Hannah David
Daniel Adam William Christian John Joseph & the children of
Catharine as by Jacob House to be considered as one than equally
with the following exceptions Jacob is to have ten pounds, David
Sixteen Pounds & Daniel Twenty pounds less than the rest
or amount of my inheritance giving them creatures which
I conceive to be worth the several sums to be deducted out of their
equal shares but in case either of them dies without leaving
him of their natural bodies him or her share of said
money is to revert to their surviving brother & sister then
thus his forever.

Item it is my will & desire that the interest arising on the money
aforeaid by annually collected by my executors & applied to the
use of my wife training my children so long as she continues
my widow but if she marries the said interest to be applied
to the use of my estate generally for the benefit of my children
and not to her after marriage as aforesaid

Item I bequeath to my beloved wife Louisa all my lands &
plantation wherewhich I now have my negro girl Charity with all
my Stock tools & mill wagon house hold furniture & every thing
of what kind a nature so ever that I do properly ought which
is aforementioned during her natural life or widowhood
but in case she should marry she is not to have the
use thereof any longer except her chain of of any two of
my home Creatures two Cows & Calves three head of hogs
& three head of sheep I do give & bequeath to her other
heirs forever

Item it is my will & desire that at my wife deceased
