

65. 2nd. I give to Henry Floyd all that part of my land
lying the south of big Dan River the line to crop said
River at a bluff below the forks. He keep the surrounding
Ridge untill it intersects with the East line also a negro
girl named Nance a black Horse & man & calf.

3rd. I give James Nunn all my land lying in the fork of Dan
River the line extending up little Dan to the mouth of a
branch which empties in on the East side of said
River running up said branch to where my line crosses
it. My will & desire also is that at the separation of these
years the money arising from the sale or hire of said
which ever he shall make choice of shall be coming to
him also a Sorell Horse and feather Bed.

4th. I give to my son Thomas & Nunn all the balance of my
lands also two negro boys Ben & George my desire is likewise
that he should take charge of Janny and let her have
her liberty so as to let her have whatever she works for
likewise one Cow & Calf the choice of my stock four head
of Hogs one feather Bed & one third part of the house
hold & kitchen furniture & working tools also six barrels of Corn

5th. After the stock is wintered & a sufficient support for the
family laid in for the ensuing year, my will & desire is
that the whole of the remaining part of my stock of Cattle hogs
with the balance of grain which shall be left & remaining $\frac{2}{3}$ of the
house hold & kitchen Furniture & working tools be equally divided
between Henry Floyd & James Nunn together with what cash
which shall be found left or due me and lastly I do
hereby constitute & appoint Brother William Nunn & James
J. Givens Executors of this my last will & testament

Resident of Stokes County being weak in body but with a peaceful
sound mind & disposing memory do by my own free will this 2^y to
day of November in the year 1815. make this my last will &
testament in manner & form following. To wit

1st. I hereby constitute my wife Polly & my brother
Naaman Roberts to Executors of this my last will & testament

2^d. I give & bequeath to my wife the land & plantation I now
lie on during & to the term when my son Alfred comes of age
then the land to be equally divided between my said son
Alfred & my daughter Sabory each an half.

3^d. And for the remainder of the property that it has pleased
God to bless me with Negro Horses &c my will & desire is that
my wife have the use & benefit of it till my son comes of age
the said negro stock & furniture to be taken care of for
her & my Children support & education and as soon as my said
son Alfred attains the year of 21 years. then my said
negro Horses Cattle stock & furniture be equally divided
between my said Wife & my two Children & in case of the death
of any of these parties my land & property to go to the
Survivor or Survivors of them in this way if one of my
Children should die then the Surviving child to have the

whole of my land & I share equally with its mother
my personal property.

I Jacob House of the County of Stokes, State of North Carolina
being in perfect health & strength of body & mind knowing that it
is allotted for all men once to die do make & ordain this to
be my last will & testament and first I Recommend my soul
into the hands of Almighty God that gave it me & my body to the
Earth to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion
of my executors hereafter named And as to my worldly Estate
wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with I dispose of
it in the following manner

I give & bequeath to my daughter Hannah
a new and high Feather bed and furniture when she
marries or at my death. This being equivalent to what I
have heretofore given my daughter Catharina & Magdalena
to her & her heirs forever.

Item It is my will & desire that all the monies I have on
Interest and outstanding debts that can be conveniently paid
out of my estate besides what is necessary for the support of
& raising of my Children be continued out on interest if possible
untill after my wife's Decease when it is to be equally
divided amongst my Children namely Jacob Hannah David
Daniel Adam William Christian John Joseph & the Children of
Catharina by Jacob House to be considered as one share equally
with the following exceptions ~~Said~~ is to have ten pounds, David
Sixteen Pounds & Daniel Twenty pounds less than the rest
on account of my heretofore giving them creatures whitch
I conceive to be worth the several sums to be deducted out of their
several shares but in case either of them dies without leaving
heirs of their natural bodies then a her share of said
money is to revert to their surviving brother. Sister then
& their heirs forever.

Item it is my will & desire that the Interest arising on the Monies
aforesaid be annually collected by my executor & applied to the
use of my wife & raising my Children so long as she continues
my widow but if she marries the said interest to be applied
to the use of my estate generally for the benefit of my Children
and not to her after marriage as aforesaid

Item I leave to my beloved wife Linora all my lands &
Plantations whome I now live my negro Gilt Charity, with all
my Stock tools still waggon horn hold furniture & every thing
of what kind a nature as ever that I do possess except what
is aforesaid, during her natural life a Widowhood
but in case she should marry she is not to have the
use thereof any longer except her Choin of of any two of
my home Creatures two Cows & Calves three head of hogs
& three head of sheep I do give & bequeath to her & her
heirs forever
