Clause 4th I will and advise that after the death of my
 wife Polly that all my lands shall then be sold in the
 process equally to be divided amongst my children according
 to what they may have already received, and that such sale shall
 be made upon a credit of one, two & three years Lewis, Betsy Mary
 Lucy Franklin John Josely Floyd.

Clause 5th I will and advise that should my wife Polly
 give it to the advantage of her children exchange the lands
 herein spoken of for either lands or to make sale of the same
 here spoken of and to invest the proceeds in other lands
 for the benefit of her children agreeable to clause the
 4th that she is hereby empowered to do so.

Clause 6th Should either of my children become dissatisfied
 with the provisions of this will and institute a suit
 to break the same then it is my will that such child
 shall be cut of from the benefit of any of said provi-
 sions and his or her portion to be equally divided
 amongst the other children.
