In the name of God Amen I Daniel Huff of Stokes County
and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of good
and sound mind and memory knowing that it is appointed
for all men one to die do make and ordain this my last Will
& testament this 22^d Day of October A^d 1793 in man and
form following And first I recommend my soul into
the hands of Almighty God that gave it, and my body to
the earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at
the discretion of my executors hereafter named And as to
my worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to
bless me with I dispose of in the following manner

Imprimis I give to my beloved wife Elizabeth one negro
man named Jacob Also one negro girl named Phillis
also one negro man named Sam also one negro
girl named Lilla and one negro Boy named Phill
for and during her life a widowhood. And I give
to her also one fourth part of all my personal
Estate consisting of Houses Estate & Stock of all
different kinds including Household Kitchen & Planta-
tion furniture to have the same to her use during
her life a widowhood and after her decease to be
equally divided amongst my three sons viz Daniel
Samy & Lemiah

And the three remaining parts of my personal
Estate consisting of Stock of different kinds
