Be it remembered that on the twenty fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety five John Fair of the County of Stokes and State of North Carolina being sick of Body which rendered him incapable of having his Last Will put in writing, but being of sound mind & memory did call upon his Wife Alice Fair together with Andrew Robinson Michael Fair & Abigail Davis with several of his neighbors to his dwelling in his own dwelling house & having requested of them to take notice did declare order & pronounce before the said persons the under written Declaration Will (To wit) He gave & bequeathed to his Wife Alice Fair his plantation whereon he dwelt, during the term of her Natural life or widowhood with every thing thereon after pay all his lawful debts together with a negro woman named Jude, in order to raise & support his Children thereon & at her decease the land to descend to his son John Fair The Newcomb Horse & his wearing Apparel to be sold by his wife toward the payment of his Debts There were the last Will & Testament of the said John Fair pronounced and declared before us the Subscribing Witnesses
