

Now all men by these presents that I John Glenn jun^r of the County of Stokes and State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by William Hill of the City of Raleigh and State aforesaid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William Hill one negro boy known by the name of Edmund to him the said William Hill his heirs and assigns forever and he the said John Glenn jun^r doth for himself his heirs &c hereby warrant forever defend the right and title of in and to the said negro boy Edmund from the lawfull claim of all persons whatsoever to him the said William Hill his heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof he the said John Glenn jun^r hath hereunto set his hand and seal the twenty fourth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one.
