I John Ains of the County of Stokes above named being
weak in body but of sound mind & memory thank be
given to God Do make & ordain this my last Will
& Testament Pg.

1) I give bequeath & devise to my dearly beloved wife
Johana Catharina all my Estate both real &
personal to have & to hold the same as her own
sole property as long as she remains my Widow
but in case she should marry again she shall
be entitled to the third part of my said Estate
to have and to hold the same as her own sole property
forever.

2) After the decease of my said Wife all my Estate
shall be equally divided amongst my nine Children names
John, Mary, Catharina, Phillip, Christian, Johanna, Henry,
Peter, Savannah, to each of them an equal Share all
alike as their Property forever

3) My daughter Elizabeth shall have for her Share one
Dollar of the United States Money

But her son named John shall have out of my
Estate one & half of a Share which shall come to
any of my abovesaid Children after the decease of my dear
wife out of my said Estate say one half a Share out of
my said Estate as his Property forever

4) My Abel son John shall have full & ample power liberty
to possess the acre of my land where he with the acre
of my execution shall clear the same and make an
improvement thereon but the land remain entailed to

the whole of the legatees

5) And I do make ordain constitute & appoint my bury friend
Endris Baker of Salem & my executors wife Johanna Catharina
Execution of this my last will & testament who are
humbly impowered to pay off all my debts & settle all my
accounts.

And I do humbly disannull & make void all former Wills or
legacies done by me either in writing or by word of mouth
ratifying & confirming this the other to be my last will &
testament

one thousand eight hundred & six.
