my widow.

Second I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Hunter five Shillings
to my son David Hunter five Shillings To my son
John Hunter five Shillings To my son Dennis
Hunter five Shillings

I give and bequeath unto my son William Hunter
the Plantation of now live on containing three
hundred acres more or less the said William Hunter
is to maintain me and my wife our life time &
after our deaths to have the said Plantation with
all the working tools that is on it.

Mary Hunter one bed one Chair one Table one Blanket
one Sattel one bow

in token of remembrance forever

I constitute & appoint Samuel Clark a trustee to this
my last Will & Testament this first day of October 1795
