The execution of the last Will & Testament
of Andrew Jackson of which the first
is a true copy was proven in open
court by the oath of William Frazer
Clerk to be recorded which is worded
as follows

Wm. Frazer
Clerk

In the name of God Amen! I John Bailey
of the County of Stokes & State of N Carolina
being weak in body but of sound and perfect
mind and memory think proper to make
and ordain my last Will & Testament in manner
following that is, first I give and bequeath
my soul unto the hands of Almighty God. & my body
to the earth to be buried
in a Christian like manner

And as touching my worldly estate & effects
whereunto it has pleased God to bless me with
in this life I give and bequeath the same as
following first it is my Will that my Just Debts
shall be paid as well as the funeral expenses
and my outstanding Debts which are due on shall
be settled by my executor hereafter named —
2^dly Whereas I am possessed of three Black
Children one girl by the name of Citty also
one girl by the name of Polly and one
Boy named Richard, the first 6 years old
the 2^d 3 years old by male parent and the
last 6 months old —

I will that the girls shall be free at the age of
of Eighteen and the boy at the age of twenty one and
the Mother of each Child I will that she
shall live with her 3 children aforesaid if she
survive untill they come to be of age —

the said Mother called Mary has been
 found by me before the birth of said
 children and is to continue free -
 I further will that my Justice for
 (to say) John Hesterfield and Aba
 field in the State of South Carolina
 on Broad river shall take charge of
 the aforesaid three children & give them
 some Education - I have them bound
 to them untill they arrive of age
 2^d I will that all the real and personal
 of my property consisting of House & land
 cattle and house hold and household
 furniture and the crop growing in the
 fields shall be sold by my executor or
 soon as convenient after my decease and the
 money arising from such sales shall be applied
 towards paying my debts and the costs
 or remaining balance (if any then be) shall
 be applied to the use of the Black town
 and her three children aforesaid -
 And whereas I am possessed of a tract of
 land lying in Surry County I will that
 such land shall also be sold in manner

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 and lastly I appoint and nominate my
 truly friends John Brown Jun^r and William
 Vose Jun^r Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament and a truly deposable and make
 void all my former Wills herebefore made
 and declare this and no other to be my last
 Will and Testament
