I Elizabeth Frost of the county of Stokes in the State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind and disposing memory do this twenty first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and forty make this my last will and testament in manner & form following That is to say First I Give and bequeath to my daughter Katharine Betting my bed and furniture to her & her heirs forever further to my will and desire that all the balance of my property of every kind whatever be sold by my Executors to be given after appointing on a course of twelve months & that the proceeds of such sale together with the debts owing to me after paying my funeral expenses be equally divided between my son in law John A Betting and my two grand children (namely) Elizabeth B Frost and James Frost (daughter & son) of my son James B Frost deceased. Excepting the sum of Three Hundred dollars which sum to my wish and desire shall be loaned out on interest and the interest arising therefrom be paid or given to my sister Rebecca Peter yearly during her natural life and after her decease the said three hundred dollars to be equally divided between my son in law John A Betting my son in law and Elizabeth B Frost & James Frost my Grand children to further my will & desire that that part of my estate given to my grand children Elizabeth B Frost & James Frost be retained in this county in the hands of a chosen Guardian on Interest until the said Elizabeth B Frost and James Frost become of lawful age and to be equally divided between me and the entire half of my estate I hereby appoint my son in law John A Betting Executor to this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this day and date first above written

I John Space of Stokes County and State of North Carolina being very weak in body but perfect in mind blessed be God do this fifteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and forty one ordain and make this my last will and Testament as follows viz.

1st Will that all my personal with my land and possessions be

be sold by my Executors at a circuit of twelve months

2nd Will my servant girl be sold among my children the girl is named Anna Buck my servant boy be sold to the highest bidder at public sale

3rd Will that first of all that my just debt be paid with all my funeral expenses

4th Will that all my children shall share equal except the difference hereafter stated say my son Solomon is to receive one hundred dollars less than my other children in as much as he left me two years or upwards before he was of age also I wish my beloved daughter Katharine to receive fifty dollars more than my other children for her services rendered and that my beloved daughter Elizabeth now married to William Long receive twenty five dollars more than my other children for her services

5th I have advanced my beloved son Henry in a note wherein I was security due Adam Houser which note with some notes in my hands will tell the amount received

Also advanced Harry mus & Peter with receipts to show my beloved son Solomon received twenty dollars

Also my beloved son Isaac received in a debt I paid for him to Abram Conner Eight dollars thirty five cents in a receipt of thirty one dollars in a note of five dollars also paid at one time seventeen dollars at another time fifty dollars the the two latter sum I have no receipts for the above named note advanced to the ~~debtors~~ as Legacy advances are to be charged with ~~the~~ Interest charged on any of the notes

Recognizing the following as my heirs my Henry Space John Space Daniel Space Hurrymus Space & Otto Space Conner Space Jonathan Space Solomon Space Katharine Space and Elizabeth Space now married to William Long Lastly I nominate my beloved son Daniel with my beloved friend Michael Dodd my Executors to this my last will and testament revoking all others in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal to the present of January 15th 1841 John his mark

I earnestly request my children and their companions to purchase among them slaves so as to keep them in the family a certain negro woman named Jenny & her children & to a negro man named Nathan he is not my property he belongs to my son Thomas Crows And lastly I appoint my son Ashley Crows and my son in law Solomon Warren Executors of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have set my hand and

affixed my seal this fourteenth day of May in 1841 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred thirty five signed sealed pronounced and declared by the said Thomas Crows to be his last will & Testament in presence of us Gis Lenville Surat Jimina Lenville
