

162) Know all men by these presents that I John Thomason of the County of Stokes and State of North Carolina do in my last Will and Testament give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah ten acres of land comming on the North & South line east of the dwelling house to take in half the orchard thence west comming again thence South to take in the dwelling house the South line to take in the branch below the house, also I give unto my daughter Sarah a split bow and three sheats also two bed cover & two blankets also four head of sheep choice of the flock two being a black walnut table the balance of my land I give unto my son Pleasant my other property to be equally divided between my four daughters Patty Easty Nancy Harris Judith Hendrie Nelly Knipe I give unto my other heirs five shillings apiece I do hereby in my last Will and Testament make choice of Isa Bennett to be my executor given under my hand and seal the 22nd day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six signed and sealed & delivered
