I John Zimmerman of Notes bearing in the State of North Carolina Farmer being in good health & of sound mind & memory thank to Almighty God calling unto mind the Mortality of man knowing it to be the destination for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament witness principally first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of my Creator Jesus Christ and my body to be decently buried in the burying ground of the United Brethren at Newburg and as touching such worldly estate wherewithal it hath pleased almighty God to bless me in this world I give devise & bequeath the same in manner ofon following Vizt.

(1) I give & bequeath to Rosina my dearly beloved wife all my property both real & personal as well my Plantation wheran I now live Containing 310 acres of land & also my Plantation on Raby Creek in Rowan County containing 118 acres of land to have the same as long as she shall remain my widow bearing my name & to have all the benefit of my said estate & the use thereof on that Condition that she remains my widow during the remainder of her natural life, but she shall have no liberty to sell or make away any of my land or tenements or no amount but she may spend the same on suitable means for her maintenance & support to the best advantage as long as she remains my widow, but in case

she should marry again then she shall have no more then what the law allows her & that shall only be during her natural life & after her death that part allowed her shall be returnable to my Children hereafter named without any exception & to be divided as hereafter directed amongst them by my executors.

2^d) my negro woman Jude shall remain in Possession of my dear wife Rosina as long as she remains my widow by if the said Jude should have any offsprings of her body they shall after the death of my wife Rosina belong to my children hereafter named and in case the said Jude should prove obstinate & refractory then my wife shall have full liberty to sell & dispose of her by the consent & advice of my executors hereafter named & the money arising from said sale shall be made use of either to purchase another negro woman or to hire one on terms as circumstances may require tho the said Jude or if sold the money for her a my surplus though it shall be after the death of my wife Rosina the Property of Children hereafter named

3^d) If at any time after my death after my Children shall have all of them arrived to their age my dear wife Rosina should by sickness or old age be disabled & inclined to break of housekeeping she shall have full liberty to the same & if any of my Children shall stay thin with her wait on her & support her in her old age she shall have full liberty to give her into such a child in one of my personal property as shall think reasonable & agree thereon

92 with my executors hereafter named provide
however that she remain my widow bearing
my name.

45^o also there sons named John, Christian & Henry
& my four daughters Elizabeth Sarah Catharine
& Rosina shall have each of them one equal
share of all my property both real & personal
immediately after the death of my dear
wife Rosina which I hereby give & demise
to each of them to have & to hold the same
as their own sole property forever. My
sons & daughters they are all full tithing
to divide the same between themselves
with the advice & consent of my executors
who shall see that Justice may be done to
each Child in particular & either lay off
a certain tract or parcel for each of them
separately & if they should find it incon-
venient that they could not agree in a suitable
manner they then shall sit uter apart on the
whole of it & divide the money in equal share
hiselewhere to be understood in case my wife
Rosina should after my death marry again
for if this should happen then my executors
are hereby empowered to proceed to the division
of my lands or sell them to the highest bidder
without waiting for the full age of my younger
children any thing herein said notwithstanding to the
contrary notwithstanding

50^o And I hereby make ordain constitute &
appoint my beloved & trusty friend Henry Thor-
christian Hearn & my dear wife Rosina executors
of my last will & testament provided however

that my dear wife Rosina should marry again
then she cause immediately to be countersigned the
Execution of this my last will & Testament.

And I hereby empower my executors to pay all my
just & due debts & debts all my amounts & do hereby make
this & swear all former wills a legacy done
by me either in writing or by word of mouth
ratifying & confirming this was other to be my
last will & Testament. In witness whereof I
have hereunto put my hand & seal this fourteenth
day of November in the year of our Lord One
thousand eight hundred & Seven.
