I John Angel of the County of Stokes being weak in body but of perfect mind & memory, thank unto God, calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all men to die, I do make and ordain this my last will & testament that is to say, principally I give I give & recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it and my body I commend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give demise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form.

First I give I bequeath to my dear daughter the sum of five shillings lawful money of North Carolina to be raised & levied out of my estate also I give to my well beloved daughter Elizabeth the sum of five shillings of the Currency of our State.

Also I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Nancy the sum of five shillings of the Currency of our State.

Likewise to my daughter John the sum of five shillings. Likewise to my daughter Frances the sum of five shillings. Likewise I give & bequeath unto my daughter Rebekah the sum of five shillings Currency of the same. And also unto my daughter Barbara I give & bequeath the sum of five shillings Currency of our State.

Likewise unto my son Benjamin I give beneath the sum of five shillings Currency of our State. Likewise unto my son John Angel I give & bequeath the sum of five shillings Currency of our State.

I also give I bequeath unto my son John the sum of five shillings Currency of our State.

And also I give to my well beloved son Charles I James Angel, whom I likewise constitute make and ordain the sole executors of this my last will & testament, all and singular my property by them jointly to be possessed & enjoyed. And I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and annul all and every other testaments or former testaments with legacies bequests and executors by me in any wise before named written and bequeathed Relieving & discharging this and no other to be my last will & testament, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the second day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & nine.
