 and the other Hundred that joining of
 William Moor line to Henry Casley
 and four Hundred acres of land on
 Hickory Creek joining John Housley line and
 Abraham Chalkers line to Thomas Casley
 & for my two sons & four Daughters to them
 and each of them I give & bequeath one
 Thilling Sterling I being in my perfect senses
 and memory do make this my last will
 & Testament

 In the name of God amen! I Johanna Elizabeth
 Colver of Salem in the said County of Wicks being
 sick in body but of sound memory do this 16th
 day of December in the year of our Lord One
 thousand seven hundred & ninety six make and publish
 this my last will & Testament in manner following to wit
 First I desire that all my just debts & funeral expenses
 be duly paid
 Secondly Having received from the Estate of my late father
 a certain sum of money twelve pounds Maryland
 Currency whereof I have only in hand the remainder
 being in the hands of my Brother Ephraim Colver
 now or late of the State of New Jersey I give &
 bequeath unto my brothers Widdows, namely unto the
 said Ephraim Colver Anna Strodes and Mary
 Hunsicker the said twelve pounds there and there
 alike. And the said Ephraim Colver shall pay

my deare pay the said remaining Lane
together with Interest thereupon accrued and
my executors or their order which in like
manner I give and bequeath unto my said
Brothers and Sisters than and than after
Thirdly And I give and bequeath unto each
of my said Brothers & Sisters the sum
of five Dollars.

Fourthly I give & bequeath unto the following
Children, viz^t Anna Luisa Holz, Charlotte
Kramsh, Minnie Frederica Wurling and
Francis each a Silver Table Spoon & Silver
Spoon

Fifthly All the real and residue of my
real and personal I give & bequeath to John
Henry Herbst of Salem aforesaid to have
trust and for such uses as he shall appoint
And I hereby appoint the said John
Herbst and my friend Anne Gann of Salem
aforesaid Executors of this my last
will & Testament hereby ratifying this and
no other to be my last will & Testament

Elizabeth Holz have to this my last will
& Testament set my hand & seal the day & year

Elizabeth Holz as & for her last will & Testament
