 as a final settlement of my Estate as above
 named and such clerk to act as Trustee for
 my son William & Joyce or to appoint the same
 and to pay out such amounts of the same
 as his executors may require the best to promote
 his interest and welfare in case of sickness or
 unavoidable accidents & otherwise whereof I have
 unto set my hand and seal this 22nd day of
 April A.D. 1861
