And as for my other lands that is not herein mentioned I order that they shall be sold and the Money arising therefrom shall be made use of for the Maintenance of my wife during the time she remains my widow. And after her decease I order that the money which may be left of the sale of the above mentioned lands together with the Movable estate that my wife hath not disposed of be equally divided between my first son or his heirs my Grand Daughter Sarah Boringhame or if then living to have an equal share with my own children.

And lastly I appoint my two sons James Davis & John Davis my only & sole executors of this my last Will & testament & I do hereby revoke & disannul all former Wills & testaments by me before this now named Willed & bequeathed Relieving this & no other to be my last Will & testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my my hand & seal the day & Year first herein above written
