Steiner of Belhaven in the County and State aforesaid have bargained and  
sold and by these presents do bargain and sell in open Market (and) according  
to Law unto the said Abraham Steiner one Sorrel Mare about six years old  
about fourteen hands high Brandy in the near side with Daniel Shores  
legans also one small man left one year old not heralded one Red and  
white pied horse, mottled in the right ear with a smooth Crop, one red  
and white Kiefer mottled in the right ear with a smooth Crop one other  
Red and white pied horse mottled in the right ear with a smooth Crop  
and one black and white mottled horse mottled with a hole through one of  
her ears and a slot in the other to the sole use (and) behoof of him  
the said Abraham Steiner his heirs and assigns forever. And I the  
said Christian Wauer do by these presents sell the said Abraham  
Steiner into full possession of the said creature with power to remove  
them at any and every times hereafter. And I will warrant and  
defend the above creature (and) every part thereof to him the said re-
