

In the name of God Amen I Joseph Winston
Sen^r of Pender County State of North Carolina being well
in body but of sound and perfect mind & memory
do this twentieth day of April in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred & fourteen make and
ordain this to be my last will & testament in manner
and form following that is to say.

First I give and bequeath unto my son Robert
the lower part of my tract of land begining at
Evans' ford on the Tar fork running thence a south
course through the low grounds to the Hill and thence
a course so as to strike his own line where it copy's
the publick road by all the East side of said line
supposed to contain one hundred acres. And also
a tract of land situate on Sandy Creek known
by the name of Muskrat Run containing
one hundred acres.

2^d. I give & bequeath unto my son Robert
my old Bed. and also my Bed Cart & Work Box

3^d. I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph
the Balance of my tract of land including all the
Snow hill with the Survey adjoining the same together
with the tract of land I purchased of David Davis &
the Mill seat supposed to contain seven hundred acres

4^d. I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph
Eight negroes Neg^r Cate. Mill. Doctor. Visitor. and
all his Children & increase.

5^d. I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph
my Waggon and Gun & Blacksmith tools and all
all my stock of every kind and all my working
tools and farming utensils & likewise all my

household and kitchen furniture of every description
except my Bureau and provisions of all kinds of which
I do dispose including grain of all sorts & meat &c

6^d. I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph all
my outstanding debts due me either by bond notes or
open accounts. and will that he my said son shall
pay and discharge all my just debts and funeral charges

7^d. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sally my
Bureau.

8^d. I give and bequeath unto my son Lewis
a negro girl named Lydia in order to make him
an equal share with my other children.

9^d. I will that the remainder of my negroes ad-
mittedly bequeathed with all their increased be equally
divided among all my children except my son
Joseph & Fountain to be equally divided among them
share and share alike.

10^d. I give and bequeath all my western lands
Fifteen Thousand acres situated in Col^t John Armstrong's
Office and also Three Thousand acres Situated of
William Ford Lewis which is deeded unto all my
children except my son Joseph to be equally divided
among them share and share alike.

11^d. From motives of humanity it is my
will and desire that my son Joseph should
take care of my two old negroes Neg^r Tom &
Peter and maintain them during life.

12^d. I give and bequeath unto my son
William old sword in consequence of his having been
wounded in the service of his Country.

13^d. I give and bequeath unto my son
Joseph my sword presented me by the Legislature
of North Carolina but it is my desire that he should
use it in defending the rights of his Country only.

14^d. I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel
my bed and Chamber Furniture as a memento to
remember me.

160 15th I give and bequeath unto my son Davis my
watch which I desire him to receive & keep in remembrance
of me

16th I give and bequeath unto my son Franklin
my gold Meow buttons

thus having finished my affairs and bequeathed
among my heirs the property wherewith it has pleased
the Author of my existence to bless me, in as equitable
a manner as I am capable I have thought proper
to subscribe the following lines from the poet having
a well grounded confidence that they will shortly be
verified in me viz.

"My suffering time shall soon be over
Then shall I sigh & weep no more
My ransom'd soul shall soar away
To sing thy praises in another day."

17th And I do hereby nominate & appoint &
ordain my friends & neighbours Isaac Dutton and
Andrew Bowman Esquires & my true son viz William
Lewis & Joseph Executors of this my last Will and
Testament to carry the same into effect and do hereby
utterly revoke & annul & make void all former Wills
& Testaments by me at any time heretofore made
ratifying & confirming & establishing this and no other
to be my last will & Testament

In witness whereof I the said Joseph Winston
before the Testator have signed at my hand and
affixed my seal date as above.

Wily Jones & Isabella Jones who after being duly
sworn declare that they were called upon to take notice
to the above named will of Frances Meaux deceased who
died about the second Friday in June last at her
own house about six days after she declared her will
following but of the same substance of which she was
then afflicted being at the time that she called upon
deponents in her present senses. In said Frances declared
as follows. to wit that the said Frances wanted her
brother James Hamond to have a piece of Cloth also
James three Shillings and all the rest of her property
she wanted Ruth Meaux her help to have
sworn to in open Court
