I Maria Eliza of the State of North Carolina in Salem Stokes County being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory (blessed be God) do this day the fourteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner following that is to say —

1. I give & bequeath unto Carolina Burkhardt in cash ten dollars one under feather bed, two pillows, two pillow cases two sheets, one gray cloak, one habit cap of blue stockings home made Shawl, one white habit & one box thread —
2. I give and bequeath unto Betty Boner daughter of Isaac Boner one uncurled feather bed one tea tick laying in my chest belonging to said bed two pillows, two pillow cases two sheets one pair of cotton stockings one shift, one with umbrella and chaff bag and pillow
3. I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Butler daughter of John Butler ten dollars in cash and three yards of calico
4. I give and bequeath unto Mary Butler daughter of Thomas Butler ten dollars in cash payable to John Butler who is to apply said sum towards giving said Mary beholding one pillow two pillow cases one linsey petticoat one dark striped cotton petticoat one old habit dress with another one dark cotton Petticoat one coarse black apron one white fine handkerchief one small chest two white & spindles
5. I give and bequeath unto Mary Eliza daughter of Christopher Eliza ten dollars cash one fine light colored habit dress one new handkerchief one new old bonnet my best chest one bonnet box two large blue colored plates
6. I give and bequeath unto Abby Butler daughter of Christopher Butler one brownish habit one white under Petticoat one white handkerchief one uncurled handkerchief one tea quilt kind with blue one old counterpane one brown petticoat one old

apron (comes) one black silk handkerchief (without fringe) and ten dollars in cash

7. I give and bequeath unto Lydia Eliza daughter Christopher Eliza one blue and white silk handkerchief
8. I give and bequeath unto Lucy Boner one red checkered habit two old silk handkerchiefs one pair of stockings
9. I give and bequeath unto Isaac Boner one large tea quilt one feather bed to cover with two cases for said bed & unto said Boner wife Dorothy one silver snuff box one pair of cotton stockings two shifts one Dutch case one pair of mixed gloves
10. I give &c. unto William Boner son of Isaac Boner four dollars
11. I give &c. unto Joshua Boner " one desk & book case one large Bible in tower two chairs one washing tub
12. I give &c. unto my dear companions living in my room one glass tumbler each
13. I give &c. unto Dorothy Warren one white silk shawl
14. I give &c. unto Margaret Bright one green checkered apron
15. I give &c. unto Johanna Holden one red striped apron two white short gowns & two shifts —
16. I give &c. unto my sister Lydia McRae one black habit one black cloak one white counterpane two shifts one white shawl (double wove) one new pair of stockings one fine muslin apron —
17. I give &c. unto my sister Margaret Boner one large yellow shawl one flannel petticoat one habit checkered with red one old silk bonnet one white shawl one white apron two shifts two sheets two pillow cases one large rose blanket & all my English fashioned caps —
18. I give and bequeath unto my sister Sarah Butler one calico habit dark with red spots one blue and white checkered counterpane one white bed case two one flannel petticoat one coffee pot one white apron one white shawl & all my German fashioned caps
19. I give &c. one red dress one white dress one

20. I give &c unto Damy Ebro son of John Ebro one silver tea spoon
 21. I give &c unto James McRight son of Roger McRight one silver tea spoon
 22. I give &c unto Mary Ebro daughter of John Ebro one silver tea spoon
 and ten dollars in cash 23. I give &c unto Sarah Hanner wife
 of Benjamin Hanner one silver tea spoon 24. I give &c unto
 Alka Johnson one silver tea spoon 25. I give &c unto Deanie
 - Ebro son of Christopher Ebro one silver tea spoon
 26 " Mary Schmitz seven years of calico - 27. " Sarah Ebro
 wife of Christopher Ebro one white Habit. - 28. Sarah Ebro
 wife of John Ebro to one calico habit two shifts one handkerchief
 29. Elizabeth Ebro wife of Robert Ebro one Habit two shifts one handkerchief
 30. Elizabeth Evans wife of Bob Evans ten dollars in cash
 and of any of my clothing left which has not already
 been disposed of one Habit and two shifts to go to her part
 31. All the linens which is not made shall be divided between
 my three brothers Robert John & Christopher Ebro
 32. My cups & saucers shall be divided between Thomas and
 Sarah Ebro Christopher Ebro children
 33. Christina Boner one Shawl yellow ground two shifts two
 towels three cloths with handkerchiefs one tea pot two
 coffee pots one coffee mill - 34. Elizabeth Gossamer
 one pair of silk Gloves - 35. Lucy Butner daughter
 of Christopher Butner one pair of leather Gloves -
 36. One Pocket handkerchief to each of my brothers and sisters
 37. I will that if in case any of my property (as to that thing)
 should remain after the articles herein given are divided my
 executors shall divide it agreeable to the list of names I have
 given to my executors
 38. I will have after my just debts are paid that all the
 money heretofore deposited by me in this place shall
 be equally divided between my Brothers Christopher John
 and Robert Ebro & my sisters Sarah Butner, Margaret Boner
 & Lucia McRight those & their executors

35. And I hereby make and ordain my worthy friends Joshua
 Boner & John Butner Executors of this my last Will & Testament
 In witness whereof I Maria Ebro have countersigned to this my last
 Will and testament at my hand and seal the day and year
 above written
