I Joseph Loflin late from Granville County in the State of Virginia, but now removed from thence to this State of North Carolina in Wata County to show brief to leave with my beloved daughter Martha Martin wife of James Martin Gent. do make and ordain and declare this instrument my last will and Testament this 9th day of March 1823 Respecting all things hereinafter. I desire that all my last will to be paid what on my part or mine by my beloved friend James Martin Gent. & my beloved daughter Martha Martin whom I appoint my Executor & bequeath to carry this my last will into effect. Then, I have and bequeath unto my beloved Son Edmund Loflin my money more than I own here in my Chain & have desired him to him at this place & having done he is in a little four wheel carriage with me in it him to the place.

Then, I have and bequeath to Son Edmund Loflin my horse and my Penelope that I left at my old home in Granville County & my folding table & my Brown Wagon Chair with a leather bottom that I left and have him to keep & have him to keep all my riding chair which I had from him to keep of before I left Granville also I have unto my beloved Son Edmund Loflin my old beloved daughter Martha wife of James Martin Gent. all my last will that I left at the house of bequeathing of four fowls Granville pine and black & white that I owned from & four Wata have lots of different figures with known by the widow Polly Spence and the widow Smith and Mr. Whittington also four new Hatched add. table cloth to be 3rd ally made between my beloved Son and my beloved daughter Martha Martin. afterwards.

Then, I have to my Son Edmund afterwards in large bequeath I left at the house of my mother Granville Wata having away & my Refused to have them up saying I have been all of him to them which I did not see more intended to do. Then, I have and bequeath to my Son Edmund

John William Whittington by him in my mother's body among which were some gold of Silver or Silver to work in a gold. With a Cart that belongs to me and want with them also twenty five and five or six head of cattle that was taken from me too & eight or ten new thirty five four leaders.

Then, I have and bequeath to my beloved Son James Martin Gent. & my wife beloved daughter Martha his wife all the debt when they became due of good State Wata that I left in Granville County Virginia in the hands of Thomas Spence to be collected when due to the amount of three hundred and twenty three dollars & 10^{cts} for his Receipt and also all the money the may arise for the rest of my old Plantation which I wish to Mr Thomas Spence for fifty dollars yearly & every year as long as I may live also my last and furniture & wearing clothes.

Then, I have to my Son Edmund all my children & bequeath that was taken to John William Whittington by him back of gold pieces of silver & silver kind.

Then I am writing myself I the said Martha Loflin have set my hand and Seal this 9th day of March 1823
