I Mary Ann of Stokes County in the State of
North Carolina Widow considering the uncertainty of
life but being now of sound and perfect mind and
memory do make and ordain this my last will
and testament in manner and form following
That is to say

First I will that after decease my body be decently
interred the expenses of such Funeral to be paid out
of my Estate by my executor hereinafter named
and I will likewise that all my lawful debts be
paid in like manner

Whereas Francis Stearn ^{of the County aforesaid} is indebted to me an obligation
conditioned for the payment of twenty seven pounds
hard money I will that after my decease the said
bond shall be given up to the said Francis Stearn
I likewise give and bequeath unto the said Francis
Stearn my Desk together with the papers belonging
to it together with my Town Books

And whereas I am possessed of a tract of Land granted
me in fee simple by Francis Stearn on the twenty
third day of June in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and ninety seven beginning
at a place a corner and runs well or short
meters less than thirty chains and eighty three links

to a white oak Hanson former Smith
 His line half four Chair to his former
 Pointers East forty seven Chair and Eight
 three line to a stake South Eight and a half
 Chair to a Stake East twenty one foot
 and a half to a Pointer in Washington line
 South on said line twenty Chair and thirty
 one line to a White oak West twenty
 Chair to a Black oak and thence to the
 beginning containing by estimation two hundred
 and fifty eight acres by the same manner
 up the land whereof is registered in the
 Register Office of said County of Stokes in
 Book C on the twenty fourth folio I give
 and devise the aforesaid described tract of land
 with all appurtenances unto Ann Foster
 Stauber eldest daughter of Francis Stauber
 aforesaid to have and to hold the same
 for ever —

And whereas there is a bond of George Hanson
 of three hundred pounds hard money due me
 I will that after my decease the interest
 thereof shall be paid yearly unto Mary Ann
 Misky wife of John Misky during his
 life which interest amounting to fifteen pounds
 annually I give and bequeath unto the said
 Mary Ann Misky during his natural life.

And after the decease of the said Mary Ann
 Misky I will that the said three hundred pounds
 shall be divided amongst the lawful legitimate
 children of the aforesaid Francis Stauber equally
 I shall be more especially concerned to the use of
 getting them instructed in reading writing & other
 useful Arts and Sciences I give bequeath unto
 John Misky the sum of Twelve pounds hard
 money I give & bequeath unto Lewis Misky the
 sum of four pounds like money I give and
 bequeath unto Mary Hanson daughter of George
 Hanson Esq^r the sum of twenty pounds like
 money & to Constantine Leach of Germantown
 I give my large silver spoon. All the rest and
 residue of my Estate I give & bequeath unto
 Francis Stauber in trust for distributing the same
 among my friends according to my written Direction
 in one of my Drawers of my Desk And I do
 hereby appoint constitute & nominate my trusty
 friend Abraham Stuner of Berkshires of Stokes
 County aforesaid Executor of this my last Will &
 Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me
 heretofore made
