considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do
make and declare this my last will and Testament in
Manner and form following that is to say
First that my executors hereafter named shall provide
for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes
of my relatives & friends and pay all funeral expenses
together with my just debts however & to whomsoever
paying out of the money that may first come into
his hands as aforesaid or part of my estate
& Then I will to my son Martin Holter fifty dollars
which he is due me of my part of my old band David
James I will to my daughter Susannah Hansen the wife
Daniel Hansen a winter outfit worth fair Daniel collected
from a certain man Barber Eighty dollars which

he is due me yet as a part of my husband's
I further will that my son Martin and my Daughter Susannah
divide my widow's effects equally.
Then I will that all the balance of my property shall be
sold and the debts owing to me collected and if there
shall be any surplus over and above the payment of
Debts & expenses in the time of my sickness for trouble &
all other expenses that such surplus shall be equally

equal proportion share & share alike.
I will that my daughter Susannah's post shall be
put on interest as long as her husband lives and after
she receives the interest of the same after the death of
her husband I will that she receive the principal at
her own convenience and lastly as her last constitutive
and appointive my trustee friend Joseph Burton my
lawful executor to all intents and purposes to execute
this my last will and Testament according to the true
intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause
thereof hereby revoking and declaring utterly void another
will and Testament by me hitherto made in witness
