make and declare this my last will and Testament in

together with my just debts hereunto & to whomsoever
paying out of the money that may first come into

I then I will to my son Martin Holder fifty dollars
which he is due me of my part of my Husband's due
I then I will to my daughter Susannah Holder the value
of a certain debt which said Daniel collected
from a certain man Barber. Eighty dollars which

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he is due me out as a part of my Husband's due.
I then I will that my son Martin and my Daughter Susannah
divide my wearing Cloths equally
I then I will that all the balance of my property shall be
sold and the debts owing to me collected and if there
should be any surplus over and above the payment of
debts expences in the time of my sickness for travel &
all other expences that such surplus shall be equally
divided among my two children Martin & Susannah
equal proportion share & share alike

I then I will that my daughter Susannah's part shall be
put on interest as long as her husband lives and that
the receiver the interest of the same after the death of
her husband I will that she receive the principal part
her on command and lastly do hereby constitute
and appoint my trusty friend Joseph Butler my
lawful executor to all intent and purposes to execute
this my last will and Testament according to the true
intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause
thereof hereby revoking and disclaiming utterly vain all other
wills and Testaments by me heretofore made In witness
