In the name of God Amen: I Matthew Clark late
 of the County of Stokes being weak in body, but of perfect mind
 & memory thanks be given unto God. Cautling unto me the
 Mortality of my body, & knowing that it is appointed for
 all men once to die; do make & ordain this my last Will
 I give & recommend my soul unto the hand of Almighty
 God that give it. My body I recommend to the Earth
 to be buried in decent Christian burial; at the direction
 of my Executors: nothing doubting but at the general
 resurrection I shall receive the same again; by the
 mighty power of God; And as touching such worldly
 Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in
 this life; I give devise and dispose of the same in the
 following Manner & form

First I give & bequeath to my dear & beloved wife
 one Feather bed & Furniture; one woodsett Chest &
 five pounds hard Money to be paid by Nathaniel
 my son yearly & every year during her life that is
 in consideration of the land that shall be mentioned
 hereafter —

Also I give one pound ten shillings to be paid by
 Joseph my son yearly and every; during her life that
 is in consideration of seven acres of Land that shall
 be mentioned hereafter

Also I give to my well beloved son Joseph seven
 acres of Land lying on the north end of my tract
 of Land adjoining his line —

Also I give to my well beloved son Nathaniel
 all & singular my lands; Messuages & tenements
 by him Truly to be possessed and enjoyed the
 part of my estate to be equally divided among
 all my Children including John Blake my
 stepson to have an equal part with the rest
 of my Children

And I hereby make Constituted and ordain
~~my~~ Robert my son Executor of this my
 Last Will & Testament and I do hereby utterly
 disallow revoke and annuall all and every
 other former testament Will legacies Bequests
 and Executors by me in any ways before now
 Willed & bequeathed; ratified & Confirming this
 And no other to be my last will & testament
