estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
bless me in this life I give devise and
disposse of the same in the following manner
First I give and bequeath unto my selfe
my faytheras Orange whom I do command
to take and ordain all the same and that

I name & bewill Michael Spockhour
and Henry Spockhour to be my
executry over my estate & no other this is to begeth
and Confirming in witness whereto I have set my
hand and seal in the year of ~~one thousand~~ our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and ninety July the
second even time before it is sealed.

I pronounce and declare Michael Orange
his to be my last will and
testament signed sealed published
in the presence of us
