 dollars in money which together with other property heretofore
 bestowed is his portion in full
 Then I give my son John Fair one hundred acres of land on the upper
 part of my tract and joining to Sillers one tract which together with
 other property heretofore bestowed is his portion in full
 Then I give & bequeath to my beloved wife all the balance of
 my estate real and personal to be disposed of as she may think
 proper among my other six children

And I hereby make and ordain my dearly beloved son
 Crawford Fair & my beloved wife Mary Ann Fair my
 executors of this my last Will & Testament in writing
 whereof I the said Michael Fair have to this my last will &
 Testament set my hand & seal the day & year above
