I do hereby empower my executor to sell my
horse unto my brother John Dine at private sale
for fifty Dollars, if he cannot get that he is to
sell him at public sale for the most that can be
got for him.

I do appoint my friend John Putnam as my
executor to this my last will and testament and
do hereby revoke all others and do declare this to
be my last will and testament.

In the name of God Amen I Michael ¹⁶⁴² Long
son of Stokes County State of North Carolina being sick and
Weak in body but of sound mind & memory do make & publish
& declare this to be my last Will and Testament That is to say.

First I give and bequeath unto Barbara wife of John Little
all my wife of John Laine, Sally wife of Jacob Pinkley, Sally
wife of Anthony Little Elizabeth wife of Aaron Putnam &
Henry Fry in equal portions a certain Covenant or Obligation
which I have on John Fry for six Hundred Dollars due at
certain times by Installments of fifty Dollars each. It is
my will that the said sum be given to Elizabeth wife of
Aaron Putnam shall be equally divided amongst all
the Children which she now has & may hereafter have
I the said give to Sally wife of John Laine to be equally
divided amongst all the Children which she now has &
may hereafter have

Second It is my will that my negro Slaves shall be
retained by said women chosen for that purpose and
remain in possession of my wife during her natural
life if she should choose to keep them a each of
them as she chooses and at her death in any of
my Children should choose to take said negroes at
the discretion they may do so they to the other Children
a proportionable part of said value or otherwise to be
sold

Third I give and bequeath unto my wife during
her natural life one horse creature four Cows
all the Sheep, three Buckhorns, one set of Sows and
such of the Household furniture as she may choose
to keep for her use.

Fourth It is my will that all my other Estate
not otherwise disposed of shall be sold by my
Executors and the monies arising therefrom together

with the money arising from the sale of the same
in case they sold to be sold, to be equally divided
amongst all my children then and then alive
to them and their heirs: It is to be understood that
all that part of my estate hereby willed to my
daughter Elizabeth wife of John Butler is to
be equally divided amongst all the children which
she may have and not to go to her husband

I do nominate & appoint Wm Foster and
William Fox executors of this my last Will &
Testament

of Robt County and State of North Carolina being of
sound and disposing mind and memory at this twenty
first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight Hundred & fifteen 1815 make and ordain this to
be my last will and Testament in manner and form
following that is to say.

First I will that all my just debts and funeral
charges be paid by my executors by a sum to be raised
and levied out of my cash realising debts and
movable property for that purpose

2^d. I will that my beloved wife Elizabeth possess
and enjoy my dwelling house kitchen & barn and
all other buildings belonging to me on the East side of
Sandy Creek which runs through my plantation and
also all that part of my plantation which lies on
the said East side of Sandy Creek and Ditch during
her natural life. I also give and bequeath unto
my beloved wife during her natural life the following
negroes vizt. Bob, Mary, and Agass and all her
children and all their increase and after my wife's
death I will that the said negroes be divided among
my heirs and that the money arising therefrom be
equally divided into seven shares that is to say equal
shares & that my three sons vizt. Isaac, Homer, and
Hazeliah and Lewis law Malen Smith and Robert
Winston shall each have one share of said money
& that the children of my daughter Sally wife of
Isaac Smith and the children of my daughter
Parey wife of Sackey Bolding shall have the two
remaining shares that is to say the children of
each of said daughters one share. and that
