In the name of God Amen; I Nathaniel Cook of the County of Hatteras & State of North Carolina, being of sound and disposing mind & memory praise be God for the same do make this my last will and testament first I bequeath my soul to God & my body to be interred in a Christian like manner, I bequeath that my just debts be paid, for which purpose I will that all my outstanding moneys arrearages due me shall be collected by my herein named Executors and also that all my purchable property shall be sold to the highest & best bidder to consist that purpose, further I bequeath that the tract of land whereon I now live shall be sold on the most profitable terms for the my mill & other buildings thereon also another tract of land which joins George Kenner & Nathan Craft shall be sold in like manner but if a sufficient sum of money shall be collected with my outstanding moneys & arrearages due me as by the sale of my purchable property to cover my just debts that in that case I will and bequeath that the tract of land I now live on with my mill & other buildings thereon, shall not be sold until the expiration of three years after my death the mill & plantation shall be rented out to the best advantage & to the most convenient hand that can be collected by my herein named Executors or the surviving Executor of them & the money obtained by rents shall be paid to the use

of my estate - all money I owe to me from Matthew Brooks estate or well in the State of Tennessee or in North Carolina when collected shall be applied to the use of my estate further I will that all my Negro Slaves not disposed of before my death shall be sold one by one to the highest & best bidder except two (viz) Sandy a negro boy about six or seven years old & the other of the name of Anna Minerva a girl about the same age which I do bequeath to my beloved niece Rebecca Cook as well for services rendered by her to my late beloved wife as for love & charity which I said to my son Sandy & Minerva I bequeath to her & the legal heirs of her body forever I also bequeath to my beloved wife afore said (viz) Rebecca Cook out of my estate two hundred and fifty dollars I also bequeath and leave Elizabeth Goodman Anderson an orphan girl raised by me from an infant two hundred and fifty dollars & one good bed bedstead furniture and one chry beaver now in my possession, further I will that my tract of land lying in Hatteras County on the Hatteras river adjoining John Howard lands shall not be sold until the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five (if not disposed of before my death) for reasons best known to myself and in the interim & time my executor or any one of them or their legal representatives shall rent it out to the best advantage & put said rents to the use of my estate, also all my property not herein named or specified shall be sold for the benefit of my estate I do further bequeath to Mary Josephine Gatz (formerly maiden name) Mary Josephine Proctor one hundred dollars having already given her about three hundred dollars worth of property Also all my property not herein named or specified shall be sold for the benefit of my estate & if any surplus of money is left in my estate then I give devise & bequeath unto Allen Price two dollars & no more, and in like manner to Andrew Bryant two dollars & no more, as their shares of my estate, and all the balance of the surplus money of my estate I give devise and make over them & their heirs to my nearest legal heirs, except William Drayton who shall have two dollars & no more as his full share, and I do hereby nominate and appoint my trusty friends John B. Plum and Matthew Rhyts of John and Isaac Ginn all of the County of Hatteras & State of North Carolina County of Hatteras my last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all former Wills by me made and subscribing this now other to be my last will and testament.

also two sheep & twelve head of hogs all the house hold & kitchen
furniture & the farming utensils Also I give to my son Joshua
one rifle gun
4th I will that the realness of my personal property be
sold and the money arising from the sale thereof be applied
to the payment for schooling my children
