I Nathaniel Phobon of the county of Stokes and State of North Carolina do make this my last will and Testament in Manner following to wit -

- 1) My burial wish to be executed after the customary manner in Salem.
- 2) My legal and equitable title to my house & lot in Salem I give to my beloved wife Rebecca
- 3) I give to my said wife all kitchen furniture, all kinds of provision on hand at my decease and one hundred dollars of such monies as are in hand, or will soonest come to hand, all in the room of one year provisions and I also give to her a certain cow if there is one belonging to my Estate at my decease, and further I give to my said wife one hundred dollars worth of such household furniture as she makes choice of to be appraised by my Executor independent of, and besides her own bed and furniture and beds and furniture for the children, and her & my apparel the least of which I give to her to be given away as she pleases. I also give to her all table and tea ward in use about the house, that is all earthen glass, glass & China ward -
- 4) Such of my books and also silver spoon, and other little trinkets &c. &c. which my Executor shall think to be valuable or of service to my children, shall by my said Executor be divided to of service to my children, equal in proportion to their values, in order that they may have something to remember their father by and their things are to be preserved for them until they are of sufficient age to take care of them themselves.
- 5) To my brother Emanuel I give my flute, and to each of my sisters Hannah Parkina Stutz and Theresia as many or if they prefer it some other small trinklet or article to be purchased and paid for by my Executor out of my Estate to be of reasonable and moderate value as it is not for the value of the thing that this bequest is made, but merely as a small token of friendship & acknowledgement for the many kindnesses received from them during my long and protracted indispositions.
- 6) To my children Henrietta Regina, and Johanna Maria, and such other of my child or children as my said wife may be consent off at my decease, I give the sum of Five Dollars and Dollars, I request my Executor, as far as it can be collected and made out of my real and personal Estate not

my children hereafter named to be by him put out on interest or  
 laid out in bank stock as shall be deemed most advantageous  
 by him until they arrive at the age of twenty years when it shall  
 be paid to them or the survivor of them in equal portions, but out  
 of the interest or dividend thereof I give to my beloved wife  
 Rebecca annually the sum of two hundred dollars to be paid  
 to her by the Guardian as long as she remains my widow, and the  
 Guardian thinks proper to leave the children her care, But  
 whenever the children are taken away out of her care & support  
 this annuity is to cease & be discontinued & if the interest or divi-  
 -dend does not bring two hundred dollars, then she is to receive as  
 as much as it will bring. If it bring more the balance of interest or  
 dividend, and that of all these monies here in falling into my  
 said children shall be applied to their Education as far as  
 wanted until they arrive at the age of twenty years when they  
 or the survivor of them shall be put in possession of principal  
 & interest unapplied if they all die before the age of twenty  
 years the same shall be equally divided between my brother  
 Emanuel, and my Sister Johanna Sophia, Anna Paulina, Victoria,  
 Elizabeth and Maria Therese or their heirs

2) All the rest of my Estate both real and personal not herein  
 before bequeathed shall be sold by my Executor, or either of  
 them by public or private sale at their discretion, & after the bequests  
 above are assumed discharged the balance shall be equally divi-  
 -ded between my said wife & children share & share alike.

I hereby appoint my well beloved friend Lewis David Schuvinz  
 Guardian of all my children, with power at any time by will  
 or otherwise to appoint one under him and in the same manner  
 to revoke such appointments at pleasure and my Earnest desire  
 is that my children shall be educated in the best manner in  
 Salem as far as the profits of the Estate will warrant, not neglecting  
 to raise them to necessary industry and having them instructed in  
 every necessary & useful branch of domestic Economy so as to render  
 them in their place useful members of society. And the said Guardian  
 is hereby authorized to answer their money or interests when below  
 the age of 14 if he thinks proper, and cannot otherwise get it into  
 their hands. And if they or either of them at their coming to the

age of twenty years should refuse to sign a full discharge according  
 to the account laid before them, him or her, or should after that  
 go to Law or Equity for an account he she or they so refusing  
 or going to Law &c. shall loose one half of their bequest, which  
 shall be paid to my next heirs in equal proportion after the Execu-  
 -tion has satisfied himself for his cost & expence.

2) All my just debts (of which there are but few) and funeral expences  
 shall be paid as speedily as possible

14) Whom I have in this will said "my Executor shall sell &c" it is in-  
 -tended that they or either of them, or the survivor of them shall have  
 power and they or either of them are hereby authorized to make  
 sufficient titles, and grant such receipts, release &c &c as shall be  
 necessary.

15) I appoint my friend John Christian Blum and my Brother  
 Emanuel Shober or either of them Executor of this my last  
 Will & Testament, hereby revoking all others and acknow-  
 -ledging only this to be my last will & Testament.
