

160 Know all men by these presents that I Paul Starbuck of State County
& State of North Carolina being of sound & disposing mind I memory & make
and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner & form following

That I will that my just debts & funeral charges be paid within convenient
time after my decease by my executors herein after named.

2^d Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Stephenah Starbuck all the property
that she, is possessed by her I married her and brought up my family when she
became my wife also one more grey color six gallon tea crows & my walnut table
to her & her heirs for ever - and further I bequeath to my wife above named
the use and profits of the farm or plantation on which I now reside which
I bought of Adam Smith also my farming tools & house hold furniture etc
but other moveable property property as may not herein after be disposed of during
her widowhood but in case she should marry again then to revert back to my
estate to be disposed of as herein after directed.

3^d I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Delphine Smith one feather bed
& furniture & ten dollars in money when she arrives at the age of eighteen years
but if she should die before that period my will is for the above bequest
to be divided equally between her four sisters herein after named.

4^d I give and bequeath to my four grand daughters viz: Susanna Conine
Mary & Eliza Smith children of my daughter Stephenah Smith etc & ten dollars
each when they shall attain severally the age of eighteen years to be paid out
of my outstanding debts if one or more of them should not live to the age
of eighteen years then for the amount of this bequest to be equally divided between the
surviving.

5^d I give & bequeath unto my granddaughter Martha Starbuck - being &
beloved Starbuck my grand son & children of the bel Starbuck my son
second the sum of five dollars each when they are of age.

6^d I will that my executors sell my horses mares & such other cattle & other articles
as may be spared without interfering upon the above proportions or bequeathing
of this will.

7^d I give & bequeath unto my daughter Conine Smith the book debt I have
against her husband Adam Smith but if Conine should die before she reaches
her legacy that her portion be divided equally among her children.

8 It is my will that at the restoration of the widowhood of my wife by marrying
again or by death that the residue of my estate be sold & equally divided
among my children namely Conine Smith Seth Starbuck John Starbuck
Paul Starbuck & Trixian Starbuck and I do hereby revoke all and
every other will and Testament by me in any way anterior made reteffing
& confirming this as my last will and Testament.

And lastly I do hereby make, ordain, & appoint my friend Mr. Bernard
my executor together with my wife Stephenah Starbuck Executrix of this my
last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& affixed my seal the third first day of the third month in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six

161 Know all men by these presents that I Paul Starbuck of State County,
an Executor of the foregoing will do make this codicil to my last will &
Testament to be annexed thereto & considered supplementary to said will
and to be construed to all intents and purposes by my executors as part
of my last will and testament.

First as also Bernard one of the executors to my last will and
testament has removed with his family without the knowledge of this
State and that it will not be convenient for him to settle
my business therefore I appoint as additional executors to
this my last will & Testament my friend Mrs. Coffin of the
County together with my nephew Seth Starbuck of New York
County to execute this will according to the true intent & meaning
thereof together with my wife Stephenah Starbuck already named
in my will.

2^d To explain my meaning respecting the legacies bequeathed
to my grand children (viz) the children of my daughter Stephenah
Smith & the children of my son the bel Starbuck which is
directed to be paid to each of them in my will at a certain
age to obviate any difficulty that may arise by the executors
having to pay over to the above mentioned grand children
at a certain time the distribution thereof I hereby declare it to be
my will that the time of payment to those legatees be left to
my executors already named to pay when convenient according
to their discretion at any time before or at the expiration
of the widowhood of my wife 3^d I further give and
grant unto my daughter Conine Smith the privilege of living &
residing with her family on the plantation or farm on which
I now reside with liberty to act teacher for family use & to
clear land ready for the support of herself & family during
the widowhood of my wife Stephenah Starbuck he owing
whom I have bound at my hand & affixed my seal this 22^d
day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
& twenty six
