 and if the land & negroes or either of them should
 amount to more than portion he or they are to
 pay up the surplus to the Rest of the legates
 Item I let Jacob Hauch have a Waggon worth seventeen
 pounds which he did not pay me for. It now my
 wife that the seventeen pounds aforesaid be deducted
 out of the one share of my estate which I have
 bequeathed to the Children of my daughter Catharine
 by Jacob Hauch and it is to be understood by my
 Executors that they are to pay them Seventeen
 pounds less than they do to any one of my legates
 that have not hitherto received any part.

Lastly I do appoint my beloved wife Executrix
 & my sons Jacob & Adam executors of this my
