2.) I will that after the payment of my lawful
 debts the remainders of my estate shall be thus divided:
 viz: My beloved wife Maria Magdalena shall have
 the third part thereof as her own sole property forever
 and the other two thirds shall be divided into
 equal shares and two of them her share shall
 be the property forever of my eldest son John Rights
 in consideration of the services rendered by him to myself
 and family the other four equal shares shall
 be the property of my four children named
 Matthew, Joshua, Joanna & Elizabeth & I declare
 to have & to hold the same as their own sole
 property for themselves & their heirs forever.

3.) I will that my executors above named
 shall pay out of my estate to Joanna Elizabeth
 Rights my eldest daughter the sum of Twelve Dollars
 of the United States coin and above her equal
 share aforementioned it being a legacy left and
 bequeathed to her by the last will & Testament
 of her Uncle Adam Koffler dec'd which had
 been settled in my accounts with A Koffler executor
 and as the same remains it consequently is lawfully
 & rightfully due to her.
