In the name of God Al-mighty I know all men by these
presents that I Peter Peninger of Stokes County in the
State of North Carolina formerly being well in body
but in perfect mind and memory thank be to god there
for that calling to mead it is appointed for all men
one to die as on this fourth day of September in
the year of our Lord god nineteen hundred and ninety
three and in the eighteenth year of independence
make this my my last will and testament and first
I give my soul to that god that gave it and my
body to the dust to be buried in a decent Christian
manner at the discretion of my executors and as
touching my worldly estate which it hath pleased
god to bless me with I desire release and dispose
of in the following manner first I give to and allow
all my lawful debts to be paid and provided
secondly I give to wife before wife Mary Peninger
and part of my estate as the law directs during
her natural life and after her death it shall

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to whom I also give all the land that I now
own to him and his heirs and assigns forever
except two acres which he shall exchange
with William Penneyer when William Pen-
neyer's house now stands and the said Mr.
Penneyer shall pay for the land above
named William Penneyer one Shilling Sterling
at my decease and shall pay likewise long
time Daffers within three years after my decease
five pounds each in bread to be divided by
two men viz Christian Monroe five pounds and
to Mary Hinchum five pounds and to Esther
Hinchum five pounds all in bread And I give
unto my three Daffers all the movable of
good and chattels that I am possessed of at
my Death and no more; and I give unto
and each child that is born or begotten
in my Lifetime of the body of Mary Penneyer
wife one Shilling Sterling each and no more
And I do appoint John Haltent my lawful
executor to act and do as though I was present
and present there; and I do by these presents
disallow revoke and disannull all and every
other will and Bequeathm^t by me made
before this And I do ratifie & Confirm this
and ~~the~~ done other to be my last will
& testament and in witness whereof I do sign
