I John Shultz of Stokes County as this 30th of Dec. 1836 make and publish this Codicil to my last will & Testament in manner following.

It is my will & desire that my wife Temperance have all the within named property that is named in the second section of this will & in her own during her natural life & the fifty dollars willed to her to repair said plantations. And is to say, I do give & bequeath her said property forever and in addition to that she is to have a full share of the balance of my Estate with my children herein named, that is to say, she is to have as much as David, Elisha, John, Daniel & Elizabeth who are to have a full share each for & during her natural life. Signed, sealed, published & declared by John Shultz above named as a Codicil to be annexed to this last will & Testament in the presence of

I Peter Shore being at present of sound & perfect mind & memory blessed be the Almighty God. on this 24th day of January one thousand eight hundred & thirty seven make & publish my last will & Testament in manner & form following viz.
It is my will & desire that my Executor hereafter named pay all my just debts & collect all my outstanding debt.

It is my will & desire that my wife Christina shall live on the plantation where I now live as long as she continues my widow.

It is also my will that my Executors hereafter named rent out all the taxable ground belonging to said plantation above named.

It is my will that my wife Christina receive seventy Bushels of corn & twelve bushels of wheat & two hogs & one bushel of salt & fifteen pounds of Coffee & ten pounds of Sugar & one stack hay yearly during her widowhood. I also give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Christina my desk & house clock & one folding table one card & two sheep on an. one milk cow I have bought during her widowhood.

I give & bequeath unto my son Benjamin twenty five & one half acres of Land whereon Lenoas living & ten acres on the head of Casper Shells mill pond & four & one half acres of meadow adjoining the above named ten acres. said Land to be valued at five dollars per acre & if it comes to more than his share will be he is to pay the difference to my other heirs so that the all get equal shares alike.

I give & bequeath unto my son Jacob eighty acres of Land with all the improvements thereon where I now live after my widow's death to be valued at five dollars per acre & if it comes to more than his share will be he is to pay the difference to my other heirs so that the all get equal shares alike.

I also give & bequeath unto my son Henry forty acres of Land lying on the South corner of my plantation to be valued at five dollars per acre & if it comes to more than his share will be, he is to pay the difference to my other heirs so that the all get equal shares alike.

It is my will that my meadow be divided into three equal parts & two parts to go to Jacob & one part to John Henry that is to say after Benjamin he had his four & one half acres measured of.

It is my will & desire that my Executors hereafter named sell the plantation which I bought of Theodore Shultz formerly the property of Snipes to the highest bidder on a bid, or rent it out to the best advantage as he may think proper.

It is also my will & desire that after my debts are paid & all my property in Land & other personal property is sold & the money collected my estate is to be divided in six equal shares, one share to my daughter Mary intermarried with Henry Hulse, one share to my daughter Elizabeth, & one share to my son Benjamin, one share to my

son Jacob, one share to my son Joseph & one share to my son
John Henry.

It is my will that my Executors sell all & every thing belonging to
me that is not herein bequeathed.

I do appoint my beloved sons Benjamin Shore & Jacob Shore my

the said black woman forever.

Fourth, I give & bequeath to Frederic Gambold a certain note which I
hold on said Gambold for one hundred & fifty dollars given the
30th December 1835 with various credits by him paying ten dollars
to my Exec for John Gambold's oldest son

Fifth, I give & bequeath to John Gambold ~~five~~ ^{ten} dollars ~~within~~ ^{within} ~~ten~~ ^{ten} dollars.

Sixth, I give & bequeath to John Gambold second son ten dollars.

Seventh, I give & bequeath to Christian Tipton one house clock.

Eighth, I give & bequeath to Samuel Reed daughter Katherine four dollars.

Ninth, I give & bequeath to Christina Lunnice five dollars.

Tenth, I give & bequeath to the treasure of the Freedman Church five dollars.

Eleventh, I will & bequeath the balance of my Estate if any should remain
after making the above distribution to Frederic Gambold & John
Gambold to be divided equally alike.

And I herein make & ordain my worthy friend William Linsen
Executor of this my last will & testament for him to collect all
my debts & owe me by note or otherwise & pay all my just
debts & to make sale of all my property not herein bequeathed.
