sound mind & memory thanks be given to Almighty
God. Falling into mind the mortality of man and
knowing it to be the destination of all men
one to die Do make and ordain this my last
will & testament Dated My last pronounced and
Signed by my dear Master Jesus Christ who gave
& my Body to be buried in the usual custom
way of the Brethren Society on the Burring ground
at Salem. And as touching such worldly goods
wherewithal it has pleased God almighty in his
wise I give & bequeath the same in manner
fore following; viz.

I all my due debts shall after my Death be paid
paid by my executors hereafter mentioned & they are
hereby empowered to sell all my lands to the best
advantage at their own discretion.

2.) I give and bequeath unto Mary my wife all
my Estates both real & personal to have & hold
the same during her Natural life as her own
sole property in order to bring up my children
who are all under age. After her Death the
remainder of my Estates shall be equally di-
vided between my three children named Thomas -
Anna & Mary their wife each of them on
equal shares

3.) And I do hereby make & constitute & appoint
my dear wife Mary my trusty friends Abraham
Stone of Bettabara & Frederick Kunkle of Salem
executors of this my last Will & Testament and
do hereby disannull & make void all my former
Wills & legacies done by me either in writing or
by word of Mouth ratifying & confirming this
& no other to be my last Will & Testament.
