by Jacob Rothrock of the said State of Georgia  
at and before the sealing & delivery of these  
presents the receipt whereof I as hereby  
witnessed, have bargained & sold released granted

and confirmed and by these presents do bargain  
sell release grant & confirm unto the said Jacob  
Rothrock a negro girl named Selony Nine years  
old last April. To have and to hold the said negro  
girl by these presents bargained & sold released granted  
and confirmed unto the only proper use & behoof  
of the said Jacob Rothrock his executor admini-  
strator and assigns forever and I the said Phillip  
Lytle for myself my executor and administrators the  
said Negro girl unto the said Jacob Rothrock  
his executor administrator and assigns against the  
the said Phillip Lytle my executor administrator  
or assigns and against all & every other person  
and persons whatsoever shall and will warrant  
& forever Defeat by these presents. In Witness

twenty ninth day of October 1794
