The Nuncupation will of Rubin Dodson late deceased
the 10th instant which is in substance and form as
follows declared in presence of Obey Dodson & Mrs
Ann Vaughn when on his Death bed Obey
Dodson personally appeared before me James
Martin one of the Justices for the County of Stokes
of made oath that it was his will & desire that
his wife Agnes Dodson was to have a lot of
land including the plantation together with the
horses and appurtenances wheron she now lives
the land to extend down the Creek to the second
Fond near the upper end of said Obey Dodson's
plantation during her widowhood or life time
and the whole of his other lands to be equally
divided among his children observing at same time
that Obey Dodson should have the lot including
the plantation wheron he now lives & further
that his wife Agnes was to have all the Stock
Horses and cattle & hogs or that he then owned
and belonged to the plantation together with all

Household Furnishings & farming utensils

Day of August 1804 I Martin Flynt being sick
in body but of good and perfect Memory thanketh to the
Almighty God. Doth call to remembrance the uncertain
state of his transitory life & that all flesh must ~~yield~~
unto Death where it shall please God to suffer to make
constitute ordain & declare this my last will & testament
in manner & form following My body to be buried
in such a place as may please my executors hereafter named
to appoint & now for the settling my temporal estate &
such goods & chattels & debts as it both pleads God
for ever my desire to bestow upon me I do order
give & dispose the same in manner and form following
That is to say first I will that all those debts & dues
which I owe in right or lawfulness to any manner
of person or persons whatsoever shall be justly
contested & paid or ordained to be paid within convenient
time after my decease by my executors hereafter named
Item I bequeath to my dear wife Mary Flynt my real &
Personal estate to be at her disposal for the Maintenance
necessaries of these children during life or widowhood excepting such
property as the Executors may see cause to dispose of
Item An if my wife after my decease should be proper
to marry that a third part of my goods & chattels be
hers during life the remaining part to come into the
Executors hands to be equally appropriated to the use
of the children as they come of age
I appoint my friends to execute this my last will & testament
