In the name of God Amen! I Richard Cox of  
Stokes County & State of Carolina being of sound & perfect  
mind & memory (blessed be God) do this 31<sup>st</sup> day of December  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seven  
make and publish this my last will & Testament in the  
manner following Viz. I give & bequeath to my beloved  
wife Jane the tract of land & plantation whereon I do  
also two several tracts of land containing 95 acres that  
lie near the afores<sup>d</sup> land & plantation to have the full  
enjoy as long as she shall live & then for the above mentioned  
land & plantation to fall to my son Joshua also I give &  
bequeath to my beloved wife Jane all my plantation tools  
& stock such as is necessary that as is not necessary may be  
sold My Smith tools I give to my son Joshua but he is not  
to move them off the plantation and all my stock & plantation  
tools & household furniture is to be equally divided between  
my eight children at my wifes death also I give to my  
beloved wife four Negroes names Jello and Del Aaron  
& Jacob her captives and after her death to be equally divided  
between my eight children and all my other tracts of land  
beside the above mentioned land is to be equally divided  
between my seven daughters after my decease also I give  
and bequeath unto my eldest daughter Sally one Negroe boy  
by name of Lewis & to my next eldest daughter Polly one Negroe  
girl by the name of Amy and to my daughter Cety one  
Negroe girl Agnes by the name of Rebecca and to my  
daughter Agnes one Negroe girl by the name of Mimy  
Also I give to my daughter Nancy one Negroe boy by the name  
of Sampson and to my daughter Debby one Negroe boy  
by the name of Martin and to my daughter Cynthia one  
Negroe girl by the name of Jane which Negroes is to be  
divided at my decease also I give & bequeath to my  
son Joshua one Negroe man by the name of Bob  
If any of these aforesaid Negroes before my children

 gets them into possession they shall be made whole  
 again out of the property that I gave my beloved  
 wife at her death Also I give my daughter Nancy  
 one horse worth one hundred Dollars or if she can  
 get a horse worth that she must have that much  
 money to be raised out of my stock and money that  
 I gave my beloved wife I also give my daughter  
 Nancy one bed & bed clothing & two Coats & Calens or  
 Yearlings I also give my son Joshua one horse worth  
 as much as Nancy or the like sum in money to  
 come out of my money & stock now on the plantation  
 also I give my son Joshua one bed & bed clothing  
 & two Coats I also give George Campbell my son  
 in law what money is now in his hands If any  
 of my property should be left out of this will  
 through mistake my desire is that such property  
 should be equally divided amongst my Children  
 & I hereby make and ordain John Whitlock  
 & George Campbell & my son Joshua here all of the  
 same County & State above mentioned executors of  
 this my last will & Testament I set my hand & seal  
 the day & date above Written.
