and State aforesaid. Being of sound mind and memory
I declare before God do this the 6th day of September in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
fifty five make and publish this my Last will
and Testament in the following manner, viz;
Item 1st I loan to my wife Mary Young during her
life time Forty six acres of Land including the
mansion house or the house in which I now reside
and all the appurtenances therunto belonging, and at
her death I will and bequeath the said forty six
acres of Land to E. H. Young to have and to hold
forever. also I give and bequeath to my wife
Mary Young a bed & bedding, one years provision
out of the crop and stock on hand.
Item 2nd I will and bequeath to my son E. H. Young
all the remaining portion of my Land at my
death & the above mentioned forty six acres at his
Mothers death to have and to hold forever.
Item 3rd I will and bequeath to my daughter
Anna Young to her and to her bodily heirs
my negro woman Mariah aged about forty four
years which negro I desire for the benefit of
Anna Young & her children and not to be subject
to any debt or debts which wife Young may
contract or have contracted.
Item 4th I will and bequeath to my son Robert F. Young
my boy Brown aged about seventeen. to him
and to his heirs and assigns forever.
Item 5th I will and bequeath to my daughter Jane
Futton a negro girl named Patsy which girl
is mentioned in a bill of sale to Francis Futton
also one cupboard and contents of it. to her her heirs
and assigns forever.
Item 6th I will and bequeath to my daughter
Elizabeth Abbott a certain negro boy Anderson
whom she has heretofore received and which
is mentioned in a bill of sale to Jacob Abbott
to have and to hold to her her heirs and assigns
forever.
Item 7th I will and bequeath to my son Joseph Young
one negro boy named William which he has

297) received into his possession and which is mentioned in a bill of sale to Josiah Young to have and to hold to him the said Josiah Young to his heirs and assigns forever, also I will and bequeath to my son Josiah one negro girl named Lucinda about eight years old upon condition that he pays one half of all the just debts which I may owe, to have and to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item 8th I will and bequeath to my son George Henry Young a certain negro girl which he has received into his possession and also mentioned in a bill of sale previously given which girl is named Vina about nine or ten years of age when he received her, to have and to hold to him his heirs and assigns forever, also I will and bequeath to him the said George H Young a negro girl named Margaret about four years of age to have and to hold to him the said George H Young his heirs and assigns forever upon the condition that the said George H Young pays to my creditors the other half of all my just debts which I may owe.

Item 9th I will and bequeath to my son John Young in addition to what I have had to pay for him a horse if there should be one on hand, also one side board, one book case, two beds & furniture one clock, my shop tools and also my plantation tools, and my kitchen furniture, two old carry aways and all the house furniture not heretofore mentioned also all the clock and all of every thing on hand not otherwise mentioned.

Item 10th I will and bequeath to my daughter Mary A Powers a certain negro girl named Mandie which she has heretofore taken in possession and the increase of said negro which girl is mentioned in a bill of sale to B Powers to have and to hold to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby make and ordain my son Josiah Young and George H Young my witnesses to this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I the said Robert Young have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and date above written
