

20<sup>th</sup> And out of the proceeds of such sale he shall pay all my just debts, and the balance of the money if any he shall pay to my beloved wife Solomo for her own use, Item and whereas my said children Florina Rebecca Eugenio Samuel & Sanna Rosina are Minors under the age of twenty one year, now therefore my will and desire is that my brother Samuel Truap is hereby constituted and appointed Guardian of these my three children to have & to hold the custody & guardianship both of their respective persons & Estates until they shall severally arrive at the full age of twenty one year, (and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my said Brother Samuel Truap my lawful Executor to all intents & purposes to execute this my last will and Testament. according to the true intent & meaning thereof hereby revoking & declaring void all other wills & Testaments by me heretofore made in witness whereof I the said Ephraim Truap have here unto set my hand and seal this 8<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1845

The words, trusts & Executors were intended before the signing and sealing.
