released granted & confirmed & by these presents
do bargain sell release grant & confirm unto
the said Thomas Johnson a certain Negro
fellow named Jacob about twenty two
years of age, which has been hired out some
years past to Samuel Stiles of the town of
Salinas in said County of Stokes, to have &
to hold unto the only use and behoof of
the said Thomas Johnson his executors admini-
strators and assigns for ever, and I the said
Elijah Elmore for myself my executors and
administrators all and singular the said Negro
fellow named Jacob unto the said Thomas
Johnson his executors adm. and assigns again-
st the said Elijah Elmore my Ex. adm.
or assigns and against all and every other
person and persons whatsoever shall and will
pretend and for ever defend by these
presents. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my Seal this

twentieth day of June in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety
one - and fiftieth year of the sovereignty &

to each sold relinquished & conveyed and by these
presents doth bargain sell relinquish and

title and Interest that we or each of
us have had a claim in and to the
tract or tracts of land that our father
Samuel Mosby did possess of lying
on the Gardens river adjoining the
lands of Phillip Howard Joseph Williams
and Samuel Mosby. to have and to hold
and quietly enjoy unto the said Thomas
Mosby his heirs Ex. or admors and assigns
against us and each of our heirs and
assigns In Witness whereof we and each
of us have hereunto set our hands &
Seals this 28th day of September A.D. 1791

these presents warrant & defend the above named
property unto the said James Martin his heirs and
assigns against the lawful claims of all persons
whosoever In Testimony whereof I the said
John Branson have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 9th day of March in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
two.
